I'm still walking that road with the Lord, alongside my kids and new husband as we discover the beauty and complexities of the modern blended family. Somehow - in every varied fellowship and season of life - I keep finding myself behind a piano, content to hold a space for the church family in front of me to reckon with our God in whatever state of belief or unbelief they may find themselves in.
